

Diversion Permit Status


- To provide flexibility, working with State Board to prepare one diversion permit to cover all 4 locations
- 180-day streamlined permit (like last year)
- May also pursue 5 year permit
- Easley and Williams have approved landowner agreements, ready for SVGMD signatures
- In communication with Watermaster regarding water rights for Staverville and Little Last Chance Creek


Lake Davis Frenchman Lake Water Transfer

- Met with Rob Thorman, Plumas County on August 14th
- Transfer is transactional, no construction or physical transfer of water between the two reservoirs
- Up to 1100 AFY available minimum cost of \$110/AF
- For initial recharge effort, start with 100-200 AF
- Plumas WF grant could be amended to cover this
- Next Steps
 - Confirm that Last Chance Water District is on board (Dwight C.)
 - Work on contract amendment (Betsy)
 - Determine what DWR needs to authorize transfer
